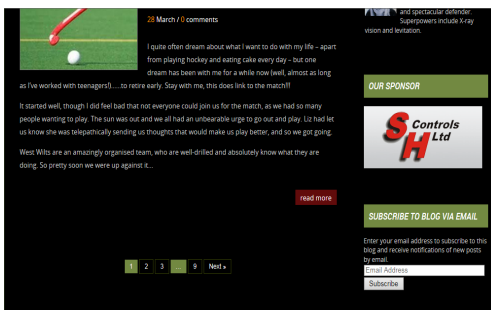

Umpires Corner

With the new Summer League season comes the highly anticipated new rules. Here is a quick summary of how the game is changing.

Ball in the air - you can now raise your stick above your shoulder to receive an aerial ball, but must do so in a safe manner.

Long corners - These will no longer be taken from the side-lines, 5 metres up from the backline. The new location for taking a long corner is on the 23 metre line, directly in line with where the ball went off the pitch over the backline.

Short corners - If you're a defender and you cross the line before the ball is played, the short corner will be taken again but you will have to stand on the halfway line and the defence will be one person short. If the ball injector for the attack feints their initial pass they will be sent to the half way line but can be replaced.

Green cards - you'll serve a 2 minute off the pitch suspension if presented with one of these.

The advance 10 metre rule has been deleted mainly because no one ever used it.
